Artworks Gallery & Framing is a premier specialty picture framing business with the largest selection of frames and matting on the Sunshine Coast. The business was established in 2005 in Gibsons and moved to Cowrie Street in Sechelt in 2012. It has continually provided a much-needed service to the Coast's arts community and its growing general population for 18 years.

Conveniently located in the main retail shopping area of downtown Sechelt, the business has a solid reputation for local framing needs. **Artworks** is known for its high-quality framing services and exceptional level of customer satisfaction resulting in many repeat and referral customers. Sales have increased steadily over the years and established relationships with suppliers and other vendors exist. This 1,200 sq. ft. storefront enjoys plenty of natural light and foot traffic on a busy retail shopping area.

There is a thriving arts and cultural tourist economy on the Sunshine Coast and **Artworks** is well-positioned to showcase pieces from local artisans. Excellent opportunities also exist for the new owner to increase complementary revenue streams through an online store or by expanding into photo and canvas reproductions.

This business opportunity is ideal for a family business or for an owner-operator passionately interested in the local arts & cultural community. The current owner is prepared to provide training and transition support to the new owner.

LOCATION & FACILITIES

Artworks Gallery & Framing is conveniently located on the main street of downtown Sechelt.

The neighbourhood is a mix of boutique shops and services nearby including Ann-Lynn Flowers, Sunstones Gems & Jewelry, Fossellos, Moorestock Outfitters, Trail Bay Source for Sports, cafés, restaurants, medical offices, and more.

This 1,200 sq. ft. space has parking in front of the building on Cowrie Street. The shop offers a full range of custom picture framing services including custom framing, conservation matting, canvas stretching, glass cutting and dry mounting. **Artworks** has partnered with several local artists to display their pieces on consignment. These displays change regularly to help the store maintain a fresh look.

Additionally, the store offers complementary retail and handcrafted items. Some services could be subcontracted to allow a new owner to focus on customer service and increase the net revenue through management initiatives.

There is currently a month-to-month lease in place. The landlord is willing to provide a 3- or 5-year lease term with renewal options.

Half of the gallery (450 sq. ft.) has been allotted specifically to framing. The work area has 2 large worktables with shelving storage. The front gallery area has a design table for framing with drawers and storage. There also a multitude of display units for retail inventory.
